

Call for Applications: Research in Women's Health and Sex Differences



Two Winners Will Receive \$30,000 Research Awards
To be presented at the 3rd Annual CREWHS Symposium October 8, 2021

The Center for Research in Women's Health and Sex Differences (CREWHS) is calling for investigators to submit their research on women's health or sex differences. CREWHS, supported in part by funds from the William H. Donner Foundation, aims to encourage investigators to direct their expertise to a topic that particularly affects women or addresses sex differences in a disease process. The work can be basic science, translational or clinical in nature, and ideally will establish collaboration between clinical and basic science investigators or between junior and senior investigators.

There will be two (2) winners and each will receive \$30,000 funding for a year (\$25,000 direct costs + 20% indirect costs). Their research will be highlighted at the 3rd Annual CREWHS Symposium on October 8, 2021.

Applicants should submit their NIH biosketch, a two-page description of the proposed research, and a budget with justification. The description should make it clear how this differs from any existing funded research, innovation, clinical question being addressed (unmet clinical need, impact on women's health), and next steps (anticipated papers and grant submissions).
